Rites Held Saturday For Mrs. H. S. Yant [Handwritten: 1959]

Mrs. H. S. Yant, 86, died in a Sherman hospital at 4:40 o'clock, Thursday afternoon, April 23, 1959, following an illness of three weeks duration.

Funeral services were held in the Dial Presbyterian Church at 3:00 o'clock Saturday afternoon with the **Rev. Sam Rice**, pastor of the Dial church and the Main Street Presbyterian church in Honey Grove, officiating, assisted by the **Rev. Jay Hendron** and the **Rev. John Minter**, both of Sherman, Robert West Funeral Home made interment in the Oakwood Cemetery.

Pallbearers were Jimmy Avery, Harvey Womack, Harvey Nunnelley, Richard McCleary, George Carlock and Elbert Nunnelley.

Survivors include a daughter, Miss **Roberta Yant** of Texarkana; a son **McKee D. Yant**, and a grandson, **McKee D. Yant II**, both of Dallas.

Born in Fannin County, February 18, 1873, **Mrs. Yant** was the former Miss **Edna McKee**, daughter of a pioneer Fannin County doctor and Presbyterian preacher, **Sam W.** and **Arabella McKee**.

She attended the old Savoy college at Savoy and was a lifelong member of the Dial Presbyterian Church and was active in the affairs of the church and the community.

She was married to **H. S. Yant** Dec. 10, 1908, and they made their home in the Dial community. He preceded her in death a number of years ago.


